

Corporate membership

1. Background

1.1. The CQI Bye-law 10 describes the right of the Board to prescribe affiliation or association of other persons or corporations.

2. Regulation

2.1. Purpose

To provide organisations who wish to have a formal relationship with the CQI the mechanism to do so. The regulation permits organisations to receive benefits that may include, but are not limited to, discounted membership fees for their employees, access to networking events, opportunity to influence CQI strategy and research.

2.2. Requirements

Any organisation with a commitment to quality management is eligible to apply.

Organisations will be expected to meet relevant requirements depending on the level of relationship that they wish to hold.

2.3. Relationship levels

Organisations can join the Corporate Membership programme at levels as defined by the Executive.

In line with bye-law 10 corporate membership of any level does not grant voting rights.

Any fees associated with corporate membership will be subject to Regulation 9: Fees associated with membership.

3. Adoption

3.1. This regulation is approved by the Board of Trustees for implementation.
