
Introduction



How to become a CQI and IRCA Approved Training Partner

To ensure that you have the systems and processes in place to develop and deliver CQI and IRCA Certified courses effectively, you must first gain approval as a CQI and IRCA Approved Training Partner.

Please contact the CQI directly for the criteria required to become an Approved Training Partner. The CQI will provide you with the application form and guidance on how to complete the form. The application process consists of these steps:

You will be required to sign a Partnership Agreement. Once this has been signed, you will then become an Approved Training Partner

How to apply for CQI and IRCA Certified Training course certification

Please note that to maintain your Approved Training Partner status, you must submit a course for certification within **six months** of receiving Approved Training Partner status.

Once you have decided which COI and IRCA Certified course(s) you wish to deliver, you will need to design the course materials and outline of the course delivery plans for the chosen course. For more information on the individual courses specifications and further guidance, please contact the CQI.

Submit required materials to the CQI **Desktop review of materials** We may ask you for extra information, or recommend corrective actions that need to be implemented. **On-site observation** (at the CQI's discretion) We may conduct an on-site review if it is deemed necessary, to observe the course you are submitting for certification. 3

Fees

Our fee system is straightforward and simple.

Initial application fee

This is a one-off fee that you pay when you submit your application to be an Approved Training Partners. As long as you maintain your Approved Training Partners status, you will never have to pay this again.



Levy fee (per delegate) You will be required to submit your delegates' data to us as soon as they have attended the course – but no longer than five working days. We will send you a monthly invoice for the levy fees based on the delegate data submitted within the relevant month.

Annual fee (per course) This is payable for every course that is certified by the CQI and IRCA on the anniversary of receiving Approved Training Partner status. There are no extra charges for variations of certified courses. ongoing assurance or on-site surveillance visits.
