

FEES ASSOCIATED WITH MEMBERSHIP

1. BACKGROUND

1.1 The CQI Bye-law 8 describes the Board's powers to prescribe subscriptions, entrance fees and other payments related to admission to, or retention of, membership of the Institute.

2. REGULATION

2.1 FEES

The Board has delegated to the Executive the powers to:

2.1.1 set, amend or waive the fees associated with membership. For the setting of some fees the Board has mandated conditions, such conditions being formally expressed and recorded and may change from time to time as determined by the Board.

2.1.2 apply concessions to individuals whose fees are due and whose circumstances the Executive considers are exceptional.

2.1.3 apply concessions to groups or sections of members on any grounds in instances where the Executive considers such grounds as appropriate for concessions. Such grounds may include reductions for members associated with an organisation, reductions associated with a promotion, reductions or increases associated with a region or country where there is determined to be an imbalance between sterling and the local currency.

3. ADOPTION

3.1 Adopted as a Regulation by the Board on 3rd December 2014.
